- The EMS crews will be able to practice their compression and ventilation skills on data recording devices, both before and after feedback. All we require is a maximum of 15 minutes of their time, and we will give them a quick overview of their individual performance.
- Leadership will be debriefed on the results of the data collected during the program to assist with continuous quality improvement through a data-driven, performance-based approach.

The EMS Roadways program can be conducted in a stationary setting (a fixed training day) or taken mobile to several stations to encourage participation of on-duty crews. Invest your time and benchmark yourself and your team.
